Group C NFs will earn points for the Group C standings according to their classification in the Nations Cup competition at the above event according to the point scale below.

Point Scale for allocating points per CSIO as per each team's classification in the Nations Cup competition:

1 <sup>st</sup>	2 <sup>nd</sup>	3 <sup>rd</sup>	4 <sup>th</sup>	5 <sup>th</sup>	6 <sup>th</sup>	7 <sup>th</sup>	8 <sup>th</sup>	9 <sup>th</sup>	10 <sup>th</sup>

In case Division 2 Group C teams are placed equal with any other team during any of the Nations Cup competitions at the Group C events, the points indicated in the point scale above for the places in question are added together and divided equally among the teams concerned, the Group C team(s) thereby obtaining its/their portion of the points. The second decimal place is rounded up from .005 and rounded down from .004.

In case of a tie for any place on the overall Group C classification following the last event, teams are separated by:

- giving preference to the team with the greater number of 1<sup>st</sup> place classifications; in case there is still a tie the number of 2<sup>nd</sup> place classifications will count and if necessary the number of 3<sup>rd</sup> place classifications and so on until the tie is broken.

If after applying this method there is still a tie for any place, preference will be given to:

- the team with the greater number of clear rounds among the scores counting (i.e. maximum 3 scores per round per team) from each competition; if there is still a tie the scores counting (i.e. maximum 3 scores per round per team) for each team from each competition will be added together and preference will be given to the team with the lowest overall score.
